CARVING INVITATION FOR AUSTRALIAN WOODTURNING EXHIBITION

Hi everyone. The Australian Woodturning Exhibition is conducting a trial this year, inviting entries of wood carvings in addition to its usual fare of turned exhibits. We at Woodcraft Manningham are invited to submit entries of wood carvings, and I've volunteered to help out with coordination of our collective submission.

To make things clear: in the past a proportion of the items on exhibition at this event combined woodturning with carving, but the turning was the key or primary technique. This year's trial is for items which have been made solely using carving tools. It is essential that any item submitted be of gallery standard - not only should it be worthy of being offered for sale, but you are encouraged to put a sale price on what you enter.

The show will be held June 14-16, (<http://awtex.com.au/>) at Kingston City Hall. The deadlines published on the website have been extended, as per the instructions below.

Here is what to do if you have anything to enter:

1. Fill out the attached form fully, (Form in separate attachment to newsletter email) and get it to Rachelle Leaver by email or other means by JUNE 7 (her email is on the form). In the column headed "Your Ref", put a reference number of your own devising which will uniquely identify each entry. For example, your initials plus a number. Rachelle will use your information to print standardised labels for your entries.

Please note that, if your item is sold, AWTEX will take a 20% commission.

2. Get your item/s to me by THURSDAY JUNE 6, OR directly to the Kingston City Hall ON JUNE 11 between 11AM and 6PM. Your item should have a tag or sticker attached, with your name and the same reference number which you used in your entry form. You can contact me (Mel) on 0417 104 197.

I attend the Club every Thursday morning and I'll probably be at our monthly meeting on June 4. If you want to just leave your item/s at the Club anytime, you can put it in the cleared area of the shelving above where the chairs are stacked before JUNE 6, but there is no security, and no responsibility is taken for items left there.
