PRESIDENTS REPORT

Next Tuesday night 5th August, we have our Annual Meeting prior to our August Club Night.

We hope as many as possible will attend to acknowledge what your committee has done for the club during the year and vote in your new Committee.

The dust Extraction system project, is now complete except for the report been requested on the dual dust outlets on each lathe with the openings at 50% Leaders were to have feed back to Allan Way by now. A prototype fixture for the end of lathe, has been installed for all to feed back to Allan Way or Ron Bentley. This should have been reported to them also by now. This fixture is to hold the tools and fixtures for each lathe, and to include a place to store the Tool Holder and Tail Stock when they are removed, for the adding of the table top. Finally the Completion of the Demo Lathe and the mini lathe dust collection systems.

Following the decision to purchase a new drop saw, Richard Fyffe has worked quickly in purchasing a New Festool 120 Compound drop Saw which has now been installed, and I believe every group except the Monday turners has seen the demonstration training DVD, if you have not seen it ask your leaders to run it through the TV Set. In most cases, groups have also had the Saw demonstrated to all groups. It is a brilliant expensive machine, and do not hesitate, to get guidance the first time you use it. It is a powerful saw and suggest you try the blade on, say speed setting 2-3 initially, to get the feel of the saw. The stand is a little unsteady and we will be working on that soon, so take care in the meantime.

We now have our 1st Aid Defribulator. We will have a training course on Monday Afternoon Aug 11, at 1.00pm, In the Basket Ball Stadium next to the Club.

The course will also include an official St Johns Ambulance certificate, FIRST AID FOR SENIORS. The Dual course will take about 2 1/2 hours to complete, but this a great opportunity for all of you, that may save the life of a family member. We are offering this free to members and their partners, however the max number we can take is 30, so put your name on the list on the board URGENTLY.
