After a report on another successful CARVE-IN weekend those present were brought up to date with the arrangements for the First Aid course and other matters like the rearrangement for distribution of the Newsletter, now being handled by librarian Mel.

Charles Castle then reintroduced Ross Baker, to complete the very entertaining talk to members in April last when he had shared with the Club his passion for the fading art of making golf clubs from traditional materials using old and modern techniques. You don't need to be a golfer to listen to this expert explaining the properties of various hard woods and taking you through the continuing development of clubs, with less wood and more steel, to make the little white ball go further and straighter than was ever envisaged. He let us into the secrets, passing samples around, that the manufacturers have experimented with to get an ideal balance between weight in the club heads and flexibility in the shaft. He occupies a fast disappearing spot in the craft making and repairing of favoured clubs mainly for the professionals in this popular sport,

After questions and much applause Ross was thanked by Charles for his fascinating talk.

After viewing some expert Show'n'tell items the meeting concluded with a tasty supper tray, which while being more than adequate lacked the female touch, the usual caterers not being present on this occasion.
