# **TABLESAW SAFETY**

As everyone who attended last month's meeting will be aware we discussed the Potential for Kickback on a Table Saw. A short video was viewed and discussed.

The issue raised by the Video highlighted the need to ensure a Riving Knife or splitter is fitted to avoid Kickback (This is as specified in our current SWP).

The ensuing discussion resulted in feedback from members about some perceived shortcoming in the current Saw and it was requested the Committee follow-up on these comment. If necessary consider replacing the current Table Saw.

Hence from a Safety perspective in the Interim Please ensure the following is closely observed.

The 12 inch Blade with the Riving Knife fitted is the Standard configuration for this machine .The 12 inch Blade and Riving knife maybe removed only if the appropriate Splitter is fitted to the machine and used (e.g. When using the 10 inch Blade).

Anyone removing the Riving Knife and or the 12 inch Blade is responsible to ensure they are correctly refitted and the Machine is left in a Safe condition at the end of that.

Be aware the removal of any safety equipment from any machine may preclude you from making a claim for insurance for any injury received.
