
Advance Notice

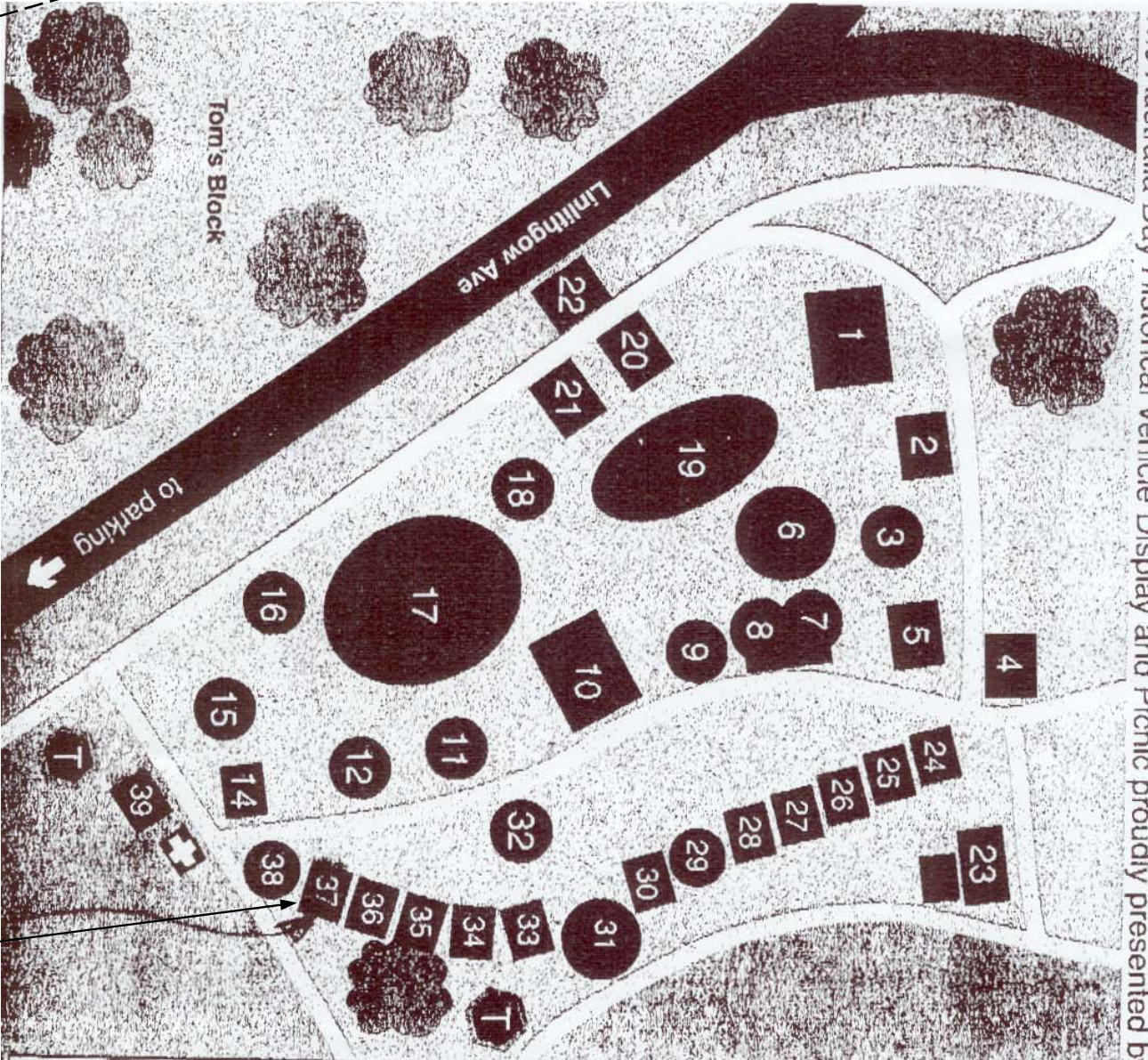
