## **A NIGHT OF PIPES AND WHISTLES**

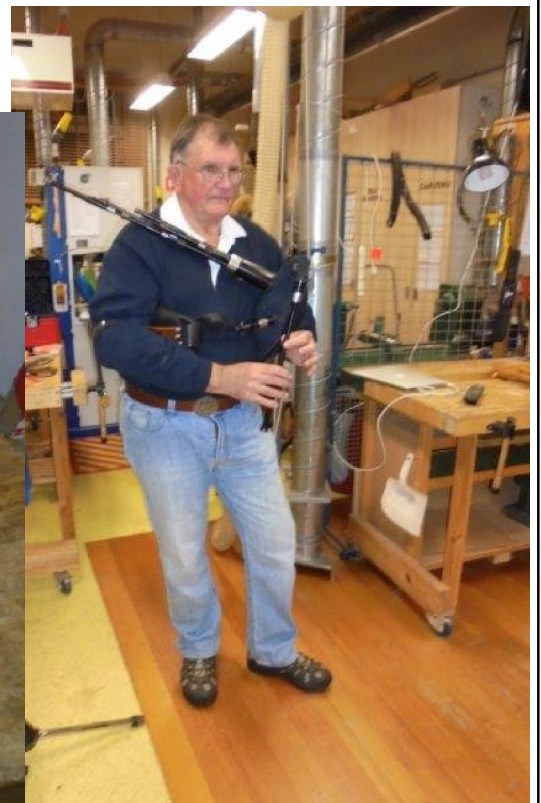
On June Club night the 35 members present were given a comprehensive and entertaining lesson on the history and makeup of bagpipes by our own David Cretney who, from age 10, learnt to play the most popular variation of the instrument and who has been intrigued and experimented with them ever since. Besides explaining the component parts, bags, reeds, chanters and drones David more than filled the woodwork shop with traditional marching music from both the Scottish bag pipes and the smaller underarm bellows instrument. He even had an electronic version with earplug that he can play silently while others in the room watch TV.

Later for Show'n'tell Allan Way demonstrated, with ear piercing blasts, 3 whistles he had turned from various woods. Other items shown were a 12 inch bowl turned from glued light and dark timber by Bill Paul and a carved penguin and chick from cypress on a white marble base by Yen Ip.

Whilst on the floor both David and Allan, who are responsible for Work Safety and Electrical Safety respectively, gave some common sense advice on the hazards of working with wood and machinery, particularly saws. President Bruce endorsed their advice and also touched on good housekeeping, particularly putting things away in the kitchen and the workshop.

The evening ended with the usual sumptuous supper with particular thanks to Melva and Rachael.
